SAD GOODBYE

Councillor Selina Daniel gave her resignation effective March 28th. Selina was a strong asset to Council and will be missed.

SUMA CONVENTION-Apr 11-14th

The Town of Radisson is sending 3 representatives to the SUMA Convention in Regina this year. We have booked an Air BNB house instead of a hotel, saving taxpayers approximately \$1600 plus we plan to travel together. One of the topics we intend to raise with the Minister of Transport is the 23% increase in CN Gate Maintenance Fees that raised ours from \$298 to \$365/mo.

ALL CLEAR!

Under the new audit requirements, the Town of Radisson had to prove that we had no asbestos in any of our buildings, or set up a liability for asbestos at the rate of \$10.87 ft2. You will be glad to know that the lab results show we do not have asbestos in any of our buildings.

LAGOON PROJECT TO START

The Town of Radisson has been informed that we must use up all the funds that we have received under the CANADA COMMUNITY BUILD-ING FUND (CCBF) before December 31, 2024 or lose it—that amount for Radisson is \$321,605.28!

Therefore, Council has decided to start the Lagoon Capital Upgrade Project this year. The lagoon is leaking and needs to have the sludge removed and a new membrane installed in each of the two cells. The Town is also making plans to add a 3rd cell in the near future. We are working with Pinter & Associates to determine the best way to use the funding this year.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE

The Town of Radisson has submitted an application to the Charged for Change Program which, if approved, will fund 100% of the costs to install a Level 2 EV Charger behind the reader board signs.
