2024 TOWN PROJECTS

For the upcoming year, our two big projects that we are planning to do funding pending include:

1. **Upgrades to the Water Treatment Plant** which involves a new post-treatment UV disinfection system, new variable speed drive pumps, new fire pump, and backup generator so when the power goes out we will no longer go on a precautionary drinking water advisory.
2. **Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw Update** which will involve a vigorous public engagement process where everyone will have a chance to have input.
